Low-Cost Spay/Neuter *Be a responsible pet owner. Pets should be spayed and neutered to prevent more unwanted animals, make a better behaved pet and improve the health of your cat or dog.*

- **SNSI (Spay/Neuter Services of Indiana, Inc.)** www.SpayNeuterServices.org - A nonprofit organization providing low-cost spay/neuter certificates for dogs and cats in partnership with many central Indiana veterinary clinics. Year-round program is available to pet owners who meet income requirements; twice a year program is open to all pet owners, regardless of income (February and October). Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) Assistance *Help reduce the stray and feral cat overpopulation*

If you are feeding stray or feral cats in Marion County, you are required by the city's TNR ordinance to spay/neuter, vaccinate, and eartip for identification all the cats in your colony (group) and be registered with Indyferal.

- **IndyFeral** www.IndyFeral.org - Offers Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) training and education for caretakers of stray and feral cats. These services are provided to ensure the safe trapping, transport and management of the cats in an effort to stop their uncontrolled population growth, improve the lives of the cats, minimize nuisance behavior and ensure ordinance compliance. TNR referrals provided for those outside of Marion County. Ph: 596-2300.

To Report Suspected Animal Cruelty/Abuse/Abandonment *It does not matter if the animal is a pet, stray or wild animal. Indianapolis Animal Care and Control (IACC) is the enforcement authority for animal ordinances in the city.*
